Legal basis for processing

The legal basis for processing your personal information is:

- Client information and processed under one or more of the following:
- Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, that the individual has given clear consent for you to process their personal data for a specific purpose;

- Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, the processing is necessary for a contract you have with the individual, or because they have asked you to take specific steps before entering into a contract.
- Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR, the processing is necessary for you to perform a task in the public interest or for your official functions, and the task or function has a clear basis in law.
- Article (9)(2)(e) of the GDPR, of the GDPR, that the individual has given clear explicit consent for you to process their special category personal data for a specific purpose.
- Marketing purposes: where we have asked and you have consented to receive electronic marketing information about our services. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting the DPO via accesstoinformation@blackburn.gov.uk.
